

Why is the NRV Experience important? Talent attraction and retention is a critical factor in supporting the four main industries in Virginia's New River Valley: Advanced Manufacturing, Information Technology, Unmanned Systems, and Food Processing & Agribusiness.

According to Virginia Tech's First Destination After Graduation report on 2021-2022 graduates, 68% of respondents had some type of career-related experience during college. Additionally, 17% of respondents said their first job resulted from networking and 11% of the respondents stated their first job resulted from working or volunteering with their employer in the past.
